We residents of Elm and Market Streets request increased lighting and better security for the alcove in the front of the Fletcher School.

In the past three weeks, there have been at least three cars vandalized at night in the unlit spaces in front of the school.

Unfortunately, security problems like these are not new to the neighborhood. The alcove, directly across from #90 Elm Street, is behind a solid brick wall that is 15' tall. There have been trouble with teens, alcohol, drugs and worse behind it.

We ask you to act quickly to help us. We want to participate in planning the solution --both the placement of new lighting and securing the alcove.


