- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Francis J. Mulcahy, D.M.D., late retired Cambridge Dentist; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Mulcahy, a 1924 Tufts University Dental School graduate, served his country during World War II as the Senior Dental Officer aboard the USS Ranger and as Head of Oral Surgery at the Naval Dental Clinic in Newport, Rhode Island; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Mulcahy maintained a general dentistry practice, with offices in Harvard Square for more than 45 years, while also donating his services to the dental clinic at the Cambridge Hospital for many years prior to his retirement in 1975; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Mulcahy has been credited for founding the dental clinic at the Youville Hospital; a clinic he was proud of, as he was for his work with children throughout the years, always attempting to relieve their general fears of the "visit to the dentist"; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Alina Mulcahy and to the entire Mulcahy family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Mulcahy on behalf of the entire City Council.
