WHEREAS: The Agassiz Neighborhood Council has had the foresight and courage to notify neighbors who have failed to comply with said ordinances; and

WHEREAS: The Agassiz Neighborhood Council has "dumped symbolic pails of sand on the sidewalks of the following: 10-12 Wendell Street, 105 Oxford Street, the Gulf Station at Massachusetts Avenue and Garfield Street, the land at the corner of Garfield and Massachusetts Avenue, owned by the MBTA, and 8-10 Eustis Street; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to congratulate the Agassiz Neighborhood Council on taking this affirmative action and to request the Department of Public Works to send letters informing the owners of these properties that these properties will be watched carefully next year for violations of the snow and ice ordinances and that the ordinances will be strictly enforced.
