WHEREAS: The City Council was deeply saddened to learn of the death of VIOLET P. (HEADLEY) MOORE on November 18, 1994, after a brief illness; and

WHEREAS: VIOLET P. (HEADLEY) MOORE was born on May 30, 1930, grew in Cambridge, was educated in Cambridge Public Schools, and was a resident of the City of Cambridge for most of her natural life; and

WHEREAS: A deeply religious and spiritual woman, VIOLET P. (HEADLEY) MOORE joined St. Paul AME Church at an early age and remained one of its committed members until her untimely illness, and was also a devoted member of the Margaret Hazel Missionary Society, through whose work she was often to be found visiting the homebound as well as those in hospitals and nursing homes; and

WHEREAS: VIOLET P. (HEADLEY) MOORE was equally active in secular service to her community, as a Cambridge Auxiliary Police Officer and a School Crossing Guard, continually concerned for the safety and welfare of us and our children; and

WHEREAS: In addition to these accomplishments, VIOLET P. (HEADLEY) MOORE was a successful entrepreneur for many years, operating her own business, the "Moore Limousine Service;" and

WHEREAS: VIOLET P. (HEADLEY) MOORE was the wife of Gurley "Archie" Moore, the mother of Clairmont, Revenend Michael, and Floneva Moore, and the grandmother of Clairmont Moore, Jr.; and

WHEREAS: VIOLET P. (HEADLEY) MOORE is also survived by her brothers, Esric Headley and the late Reverend Clairmont Headley, a cousin, Veta Dodson, her husband Lewis and their two sons, Michael and Mark Dodson, and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, godchildren, and other relatives and friends; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council does hereby offer its sincere condolences to the family and friends of VIOLET P. (HEADLEY) MOORE in this, their time of profound loss; and be it further
