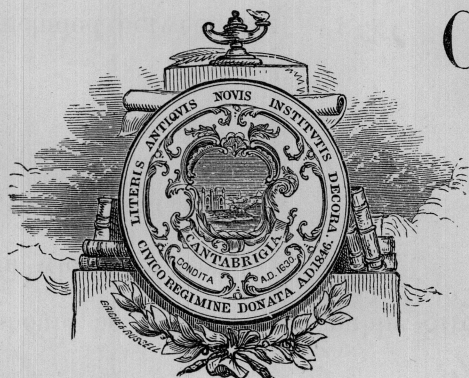




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

July 16, 1873,

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Fifth Street
from Gore St. to Winter St.,
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *Fifty feet*
in width between

Gore St. and Winter St.,

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

J. G. Chase
dated Sept. 7, 1871,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the
removal of fences or other obstructions now
standing on the land so taken as aforesaid,

Adopted. Seven days for concurrence.
