WHEREAS:

The proposed state aid to Cambridge for fiscal 1976 is less than the aid received this past fiscal year, and

WHEREAS:

This City Council is on record in support of a municipal budget that reflects no tax increases, now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the Cambridge City Council strongly urges our state legislators to prohibit any increases in the Middlesex County budget without concurrent increases in state aid, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That a copy of this resolution be sent to the Cambridge Legislators, including Representative Charles Flaherty, Chairman of the House Committee on Counties and Senator Joseph Tully, Chairman of the Senate Committee on Counties.
