- WHEREAS: the noise resulting from cars and trucks using railroad crossings is a common source of complaints from nearby residents and businesses; and
- WHEREAS: such noise has been effectively attenuated in other parts of Cambridge through the use of a rubber-like covering at the immediate crossing area; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: that the City Manager respectfully be requested to meet with the appropriate railroad authorities in order to implement a means of abating the noise which emanates from vehicular traffic using the Cambridge Street railroad crossing near Millers River Apartments in East Cambridge.
