**WHEREAS:**

Lawrence F. O'Rourke, a former employee of the Public Works Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Public Works Department on June 16, 1924 and was pensioned on July 1, 1965 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 77, of the General Laws and died on June 12, 1973, having served not less than forty-one years, and

**WHEREAS:**

at the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Helen V. O'Rourke, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

**ORDERED:**

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious services performed by Lawrence F. O'Rourke, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Helen V. O'Rourke, widow of Lawrence F. O'Rourke, of \$2000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.


