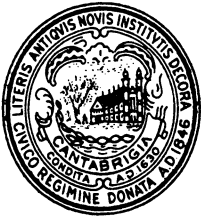
Council Order #15 - September 27 -

The Public Works Department with the assistance of Griffin Company, has completed its survey of all public buildings including costs on a short term basis, for immediate repairs, and long term goal to preserve and rehab these buildings as previously stated.

The buildings have suffered from neglect and lack of maintenance for many years. In the next couple of weeks I will be providing you with my recommendation for a major rehab program, using a combination of the following:

City Rehabilitation Funds
Public Works Federal Grant Funding
Community Development Program Grant Funding

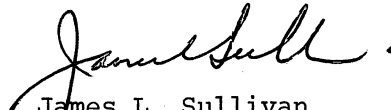
