To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$1,090,000 to the Public Investment Fund Schools Extraordinary Expenditures account to provide funds for renovations to the Rindge School of Technical Arts and the acquisition of equipment for the programs that the school offers. This appropriation will be funded in part from a transfer of bond proceeds from the December 1, 2000 that are available due to lower than anticipated costs for renovations to the Fitzgerald School and other elementary schools (\$882,965) and Free Cash (\$207,035). The appropriation made under the loan order for these projects shall be reduced by \$883,965.
