Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.

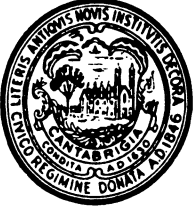

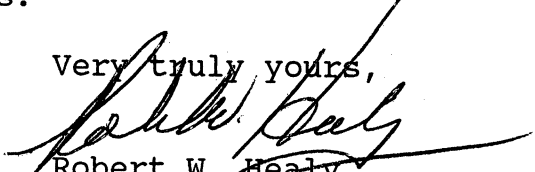

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report #28 regarding the feasibility of the City's 13 designated neighborhoods starting their own community newspaper, please be advised of the following:

At this time, the North Cambridge News currently uses portions of its Stabilization Committee grant from the City to fund its neighborhood newspaper. The budget for the newsletter, net advertising income, is approximately \$40,000. If this model is used for other neighborhoods, the total cost would approximate \$480,000 in additional funds, an expenditure I do not recommend at this time. However, a scaled-down version may be possible at a more modest cost. This alternative will be pursued during FY96 departmental budget deliberations.
