AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an Ordinance entitled:

"Fire Department and Police Department."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Section 7 of the Revised Ordinances entitled "Fire Department and Police Department" is hereby amended by adding after the word "men" in the ninth line the words "and two police women". As amended said section to read as follows:-

Section 7. The police department shall maintain not less than three police stations, one central station with police headquarters, centrally located, one station in North Cambridge and one station in East Cambridge. The police force shall consist of at least one hundred and forty-five regular men and not more one hundred and fifty-five regular men and two police women. The fire department shall maintain thirteen stations. The fire force shall consist of at least one hundred and fifteen permanent men and not more than one hundred thirty-five permanent and call men.
