of the City of Cambridge:

The undersigned respectfully pray for permission to run an open drain from their premises in the City sewer on Sherman Street.

Your petitioner is a corporation duly organized according to law and having an usual place of business in Cambridge abutting on Sherman Street, Walden Street and Wood Street. The nature of the business of your petitioner is the harvesting of clay and the manufacture of earthen-ware, flower pots, etc.

In order to harvest said clay, it is necessary to maintain a pump to keep your petitioner's clay pit dry. Your petitioner, at the present time, has said pump at a distance of approximately 175 feet from said Sherman Street sewer.

It is essential to the proper maintenance of the said pump that a connection be established with said Sherman Street sewer; by the most direct line;

Wherefore, your petitioner respectfully prays that permission to establish said drain may be granted.
