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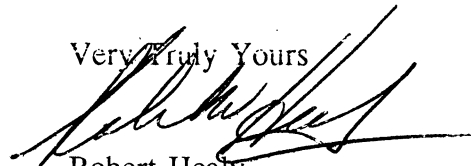

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$19,000.00 into the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary & Wages Account (\$13,670.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$4,830.00), and Travel & Training Account (\$500.00) from the Executive Office of Communities and Development. The Reclaim Our Community (ROC) program has been funded by EOCD for three years. The program, operated by the Area IV Crime Task Force and DHSP Community & Youth Division, provides neighborhood support services and initiatives. The mission of the program is to reduce incidents of crime and substance abuse in Area IV. The program runs the annual Drug Free Fair at Sennott Park, convenes and conducts community meetings, publishes a newsletter along with many other neighborhood outreach efforts. This grant is for six month period from July 1 through December 31. EOCD will reconsider funding for the remainder of the fiscal year at a later time.
