AN ORDER CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975

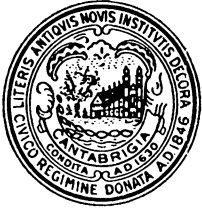

I respectfully request an additional appropriation of \$15,625.00 to be transferred from the Parking Fund to the Traffic and Parking Department's Budget as follows:

Ordinary Maintenance (300)	\$ 5,625.00
Extraordinary Expenditures (400)	<u>10,000.00</u>
Total	\$15,625.00

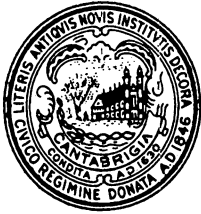
The \$5,625.00 in the Ordinary Maintenance Account is to be used to lease the parking lot on Green Street at the rear of the Police Station for the parking of police vehicles only. This will remove the traffic hazard around the Police Station that is caused by police cruisers double parking around the station.

The \$10,000.00 in the Extraordinary Expenditure Account is to be used to purchase four (4) large motorcycles to be used for enforcing all moving violations in the City all year round. The existing small motorcycles are dangerous and cannot be used during the winter months or in inclement weather.


