

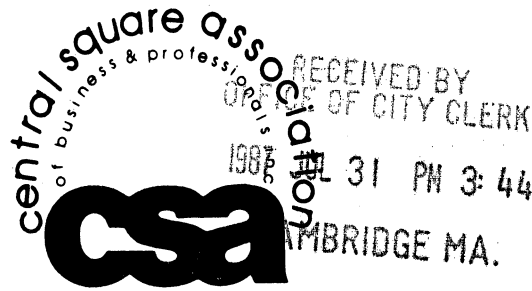

Gentlemen:

For more than two years, the local residents and the Central Square business community has been plagued by consistent violation of Cambridge City ordinances, at the above location pertaining to the following:

placing of raw garbage and rubbish on sidewalk at all hours on every day of the week, including Sundays;

maintaining unhealthy condition that has brought rats, vermin, and a horrible stench, especially during hot and humid weather, as we have had during the past several weeks;

maintaining a health hazard to all of the nearby residents and places of business by providing breeding places for rats and vermin;

depriving the nearby residents, especially the elderly in the housing for the elderly on Green Street, of the ability to even walk the streets without being forced to view the unsightly and unhealthy piles of debris.

There seems to be an absolute lack of consideration for anybody in the neighborhood. We request that the City Council, through its various agencies, put an immediate stop to what constitutes the deprivation of the right of so many of us to enjoy our ability to walk through clean and healthy streets.

There are 291 signatures on the attached petition. These signatures were obtained in only a few days and, if necessary, we are able to obtain at least as many more from additional people who use the nearby area and who were not available. Not one single person refused to sign the petition when asked to do so.
