COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

ORDERED:

That this City Council go on record requesting the Civil Defense Department of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to take immediate action to prepare a pamphlet which will inform our citizens of the devastation which will result to our cities and towns in the event of nuclear warfare, the effects of nuclear fallout on the health of those who survive an atomic blast and the futility of evacuation plans and shelters to counteract radiation; and be it further

ORDERED:

That this City Council request the Civil Defense Department to conduct a program through all the media urging the citizens of Massachusetts to communicate to their Representatives in Congress and the Legislature the necessity of continuing negotiations with foreign powers to resurrect the Salt II talks to prevent the irrevocable damage to our hemisphere and the world which would result from nuclear warfare.
