Further, that in addition to the Police Department and other agencies' involvement in the probe, the City Manager request the Commissioner of Inspectional Services to investigate the situation and use all the code-enforcement powers within his jurisdiction as a tool to terminate the presence of what appears to be a drug house; and be it further

**ORDERED:** That the City Manager report back to this Council regarding this matter at the first regularly scheduled Council Session in September, 1992.

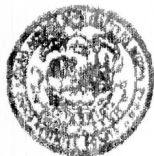
