## COUNCILLOR WALSH

**WHEREAS:** In recent weeks there has been much discussion about abandoned property and the potential hazards and blight that they cause to the neighborhoods; and

**WHEREAS:** This Councillor has observed two abandoned properties, one on Prospect Street near Cambridge Street and one on the corner of Washington and Columbia Streets; and

**WHEREAS:** Both of these properties have been abandoned for a long time and could easily be the cause of a fire; now therefore be it

**ORDERED:** That the City Manager ask the Building Department to examine these properties and provide some form of a history of the properties as soon as possible and, in addition, to examine the properties on safety issues and have a Board of Survey review the properties, if necessary. Further it is requested that the City Manager ask the Executive Director of the Rent Control Board to explain what action the Board has taken regarding these properties. The City Manager is to report back to the City Council within two weeks.
