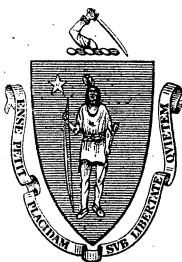

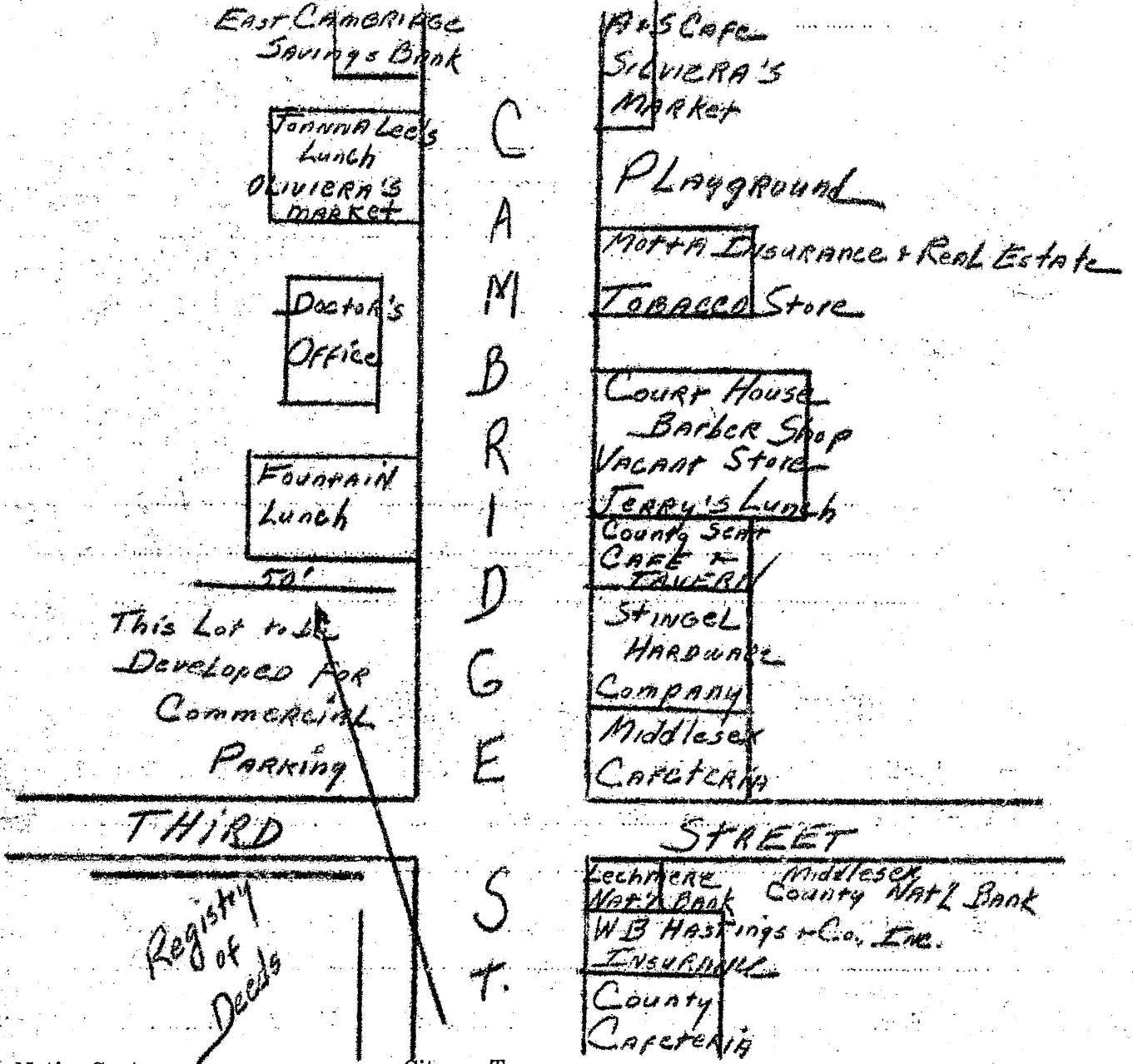

RULES AND REGULATIONS

“Sec. 2-D. Upon receipt by the Authority of an application for a permit to post or erect a billboard, sign or other advertising device under this section, notice thereof and a copy of the application will be sent by the Authority to the city or town where such billboard, sign or other advertising device is to be located. If the city or town objects to the location it shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of said notice, file with the Authority its objections, in writing, and thereupon the Authority will notify the applicant, who will be allowed ten (10) days from the date of such notice to file reasons, if any, why a permit should be granted. A hearing will be given by the Authority before final action is taken upon such applications, if requested.”

Please, therefore notify the Authority on each application whether you approve, disapprove or request a hearing stating the application number.



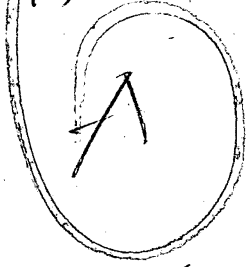
