- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of former City Councillor and Attorney Andrew T. Trodden; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Trodden, a life-long resident, was a graduate of Rindge Technical High School, St. Anselm's and Boston College Law School; and
- WHEREAS: While attending Law School, Mr. Trodden served as a Motorcycle Officer and Sergeant with the Cambridge Police Department later transferring to the Massachusetts State Police as a Detective Lieutenant; and
- WHEREAS: After being admitted to the Massachusetts Bar in 1940 he served as first Assistant Attorney General in charge of the Criminal Division and from 1954-1957 as Plymouth County District Attorney; and
- WHEREAS: In 1959 Mr. Trodden was first elected to the Cambridge City Council serving from 1960 to 1966 and was later appointed City Solicitor and an Election Commissioner until 1974; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Trodden was honored in 1978 by the Rindge Alumni Association as Man of the Year and in 1979 retired from private law practice; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathies to the Trodden family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Trodden family on behalf of the entire City Council.
