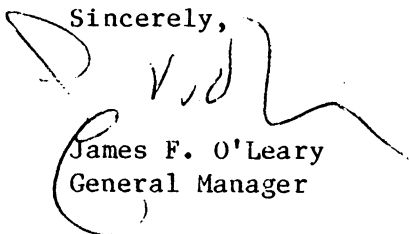

This Committee meets monthly to consider shelter requests in accordance with standards established recently by the MBTA Board of Directors. These standards require, for example, that a minimum of one hundred passengers per day board buses at proposed shelter sites. Among those sites meeting this standard, special consideration is given to locations which serve a high proportion of elderly or handicapped persons.

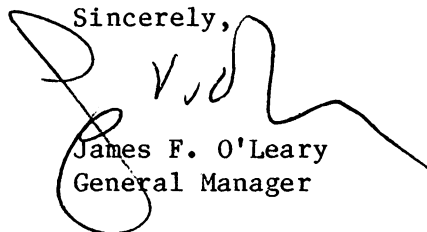
