The cheerleaders, led by their Coach Debbie Gentile, gave invaluable support and encouragement to the Falcons; now therefore be it

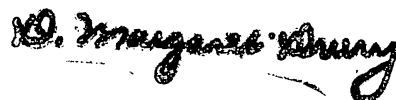
