Eric Johnson, John Saia and Richard Looney were on their way home to Cambridge when they observed a man in a park near Brookline grab a woman and throw her to the ground and began screaming for help; and

WHEREAS:

These youths put themselves in danger in an effort to save a young woman from a savage crime and did so without fear of their own safety; new therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude and appreciation to Eric Johnson, John Saia and Richard Looney for their humane efforts on Thursday, June 4, 1981; and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to each young man on behalf of the entire City Council.
