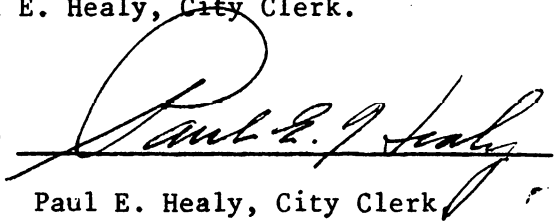

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that the Reverend Dennis A. Dever has recently been transferred from his assignment as Pastor of St. Mary of the Annunciation Church, Cambridge to a new parish, St. Clement's in Somerville; and
- WHEREAS: Fr. Dever attended St. John's Seminary in Brighton and was ordained into the priesthood in 1960 and held a parish assignment at St. John's Church, in Quincy prior to joining St. James Apostolate, a missionary organization founded by the late Richard Cardinal Cushing in order to serve the spiritual needs of Catholics in foreign countries; and serving with the Apostolate Fr. Dever attended to the needs of the Peruvian people and later served as Executive Director of the Missionary Program for six years, prior to being appointed Pastor of St. Mary's, Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: During his tenure, he was a leading force within the community, serving not only the parish but all the people of Cambridge, making himself available to anyone who needed spiritual or personal guidance; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere gratitude to the Reverend Dennis A. Dever for his complete devotion to the people of Cambridge and to further wish him well and Godspeed in his new pastoral assignment; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Fr. Dever on behalf of the entire City Council.
