COUNCILLOR WALSH

- WHEREAS: With the anticipated retirement of Police Chief Anthony Paolillo during the new year and the appointment of a Police Commissioner during the same period, the following questions arise as to the impact of these events on the membership of the Cambridge License Commission:
- Does appointment as Police Commissioner carry with it automatic membership on the License Commission?
 - If a new Police Chief is appointed, will that person automatically succeed to the position on the License Commission held presently by Chief Paolillo?
 - In the event that the Police Commissioner is not de iure a member of the License Commission and that a new Police Chief is not appointed, then, who and by what means is appointment made of the third member of the License Commission to take the place of the present Police Chief at the time of his retirement to assure the presence of the Police Department on the License Commission; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to this City Council with specificity to these inquiries no later than January 7, 1991.
