ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to determine a plan of action to assist the U.S. Census Bureau in reaching all residents in Cambridge for the 1990 Census. Historically, the U.S. Census has for a variety of reasons undercounted minority citizens and low-income citizens. Since the accuracy of the Census affects the issues of congressional representation and the availability of scarce federal resources, the City Manager is encouraged to denote specific efforts toward assisting community awareness of the Census.
