

To the Mayor and Aldermen of the City
of Cambridge, the undersigned, legal voters of
Cambridge, respectfully represent; —

That the public accommodation requires
a more direct road than now exists between the
First Ward of Cambridge, and the principal village
of the town of Somerville.

That a convenient road, about two thousand
feet long, might be laid out over the bed of the now
disused Howard Branch Rail Road, from Oxford
Street to Hampshire Street.

That about one half of the line of the proposed
road belongs to two persons who are ready to dedicate it
to the public use; And

That your petitioners understand that the rest
of the road might be laid out and built at small
expense to the City.

Wherefore they respectfully ask your honorable
body to take measures to open and lay out a public
highway along the route above described.

And, as in duty bound, will ever
pray.
