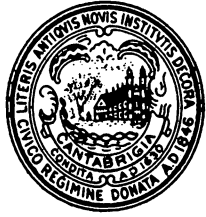
The Public Works Department this year will make an extra effort to instruct plow operators not to pile snow on sidewalks throughout the City, especially in the crosswalk areas.

In addition, after plow operations on streets has been completed, the department has contracted with additional front end loaders, and we will proceed to clear the crosswalks throughout the City, particularly areas used by the elderly and school children, by priority.

Please be advised that this additional work is estimated to increase the budget for snow removal substantially this year, depending on the amount of snow we receive.

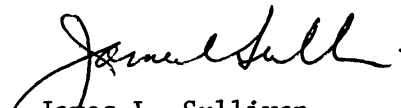
