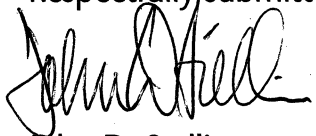

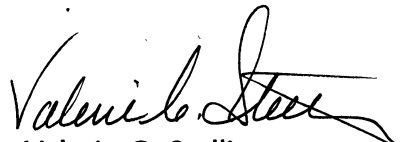
Dear Ms. Drury,
