

City of Cambridge

On the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty six.

An Ordinance establishing the salary of the city clerk, and for other purposes.

7 Section One. From and after the first Monday in January, 1867, the city clerk shall receive an annual salary of two thousand dollars, exclusive of fees established by law; which salary shall be paid in equal quarterly payments, and shall be in full for all services rendered by him in his official capacity.

Section Two. From and after the first Monday in January 1867, there shall be allowed and paid to the city clerk the sum of one thousand dollars per annum in equal quarterly payments, the same to be expended by him for clerical assistance in his office.

Section Three. All Ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
