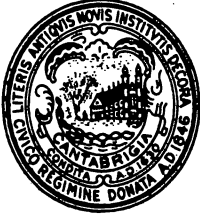



To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached grant acceptance order, in the amount of \$448,495.00, represents an additional allocation of sewer construction funds under the terms and provisions of the Water Pollution Control Act of 1973 (P.L. 92-500). The City's initial allocation, which the City Council accepted on October 25, 1976, amounted to \$4,565,802. This means that the City will receive over Five Million Dollars (\$5,014,297) from the Federal Government to finance the \$15,200,000 sewer/surface drainage project.

Passage of the attached order is recommended.
