Dear Mr. Driscoll:

I recently have been made aware of the current state of negotiations between Draper Laboratory and the Research, Development and Technical Employees Union ("RDTEU"). It is my understanding that a mediator has been selected by the parties and one mediated session has occurred, during which none of the primary issues were resolved.

As Chairman of the Cambridge City Council's Committee on Economic Development, Training and Employment, I wanted to express my concern. As you know the City of Cambridge has always been extremely supportive of research and development institutions such as Draper Laboratory. The research and development industry helps support a healthy job base in the city. For that reason, the Cambridge City Council has passed the enclosed resolution which passed unanimously, encouraging you to negotiate with the Union, and I personally urge you to work toward a fair resolution of the issues as quickly as possible.

I will be watching the situation closely, and am hopeful that a satisfactory agreement can be reached soon. If I can provide any assistance, please feel free to call.
