

**PETITION FOR LOCATION
NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE
AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY**

To Commonwealth of Massachusetts
Metropolitan District Commission

Your petitioner, New England Telephone and Telegraph Company, a Corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of New York, and lawfully engaged in the transmission of intelligence by electricity, in the City of Cambridge, and elsewhere, respectfully represent that a public convenience and necessity require location in a portion of a public street, in the same City of Cambridge, namely, Bridge Street, approximately three hundred and seventy (370) feet, southeasterly, from Water Street; one (1) manhole, to be built over existing conduit run, to be used for the transmission of intelligence by electricity, and to be owned by your petitioner. Said Bridge Street, is under the care and control of the Metropolitan District Commission.

A plan showing proposed location of manhole to be placed and maintained hereunder is filed herewith N.E.T.&T. Co. No. 05-797, dated Sept. 13, 1963.

On the 31st day of December, 1963 the Department of Public Utilities in case D.P.U. 14383, on the petition of your petitioner, entered an order, adjudging that the above described location was required by public convenience and necessity.

Wherefore, your petitioner respectfully prays that your Commission may, by order, grant to your petitioner location for said manhole.
