to that effect.

The expense of the same to be charged to the Appropriation for
Streets and Paving, and assessed according to law.

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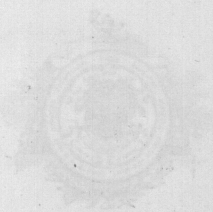
