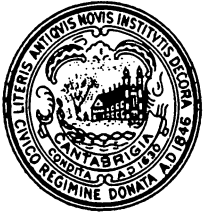

Electric Doors for Fire Houses

Please be advised the Public Works Department has recently completed major renovations to three fire houses within the City under the EDA Local Public Works Project. The three fire houses named in Councillor Crane's order did not receive any work. There presently is no money in the budget to install electric door operators. We are however meeting with the State to see if there are funds available under the Energy Grants for this work. I will keep you informed as to any possibilities. However, at this time no work is scheduled.

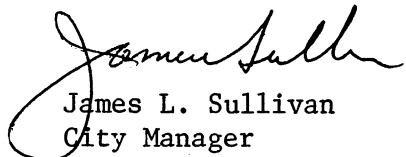
