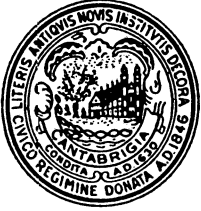


Dear Sir:

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$400.00 to reimburse Valentino Pitta, an employee of the Recreation Department for damages in this amount.

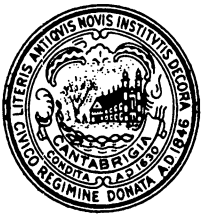
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Valentino Pitta in which there was a judgment of \$400.00.


