Chamber of Commerce made follow-up calls in January and February of 2001 to non-responding larger firms (over 20 employees), in an effort to improve the response rate. The City is treating with confidentiality the name and details of the surveys of the responding firms, a request made by some firms as a condition to their responding to the survey.

A total of 131 surveys were completed and returned for a response rate of 13.1 percent, which is typical of a direct mail survey. Table 2.1 displays the number of surveys sent and returned, by industry cluster.
