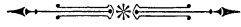

To the Honorable, the Mayor, and Aldermen,
of the City of Cambridge,

The undersigned respectfully ~~remonstrate~~ remonstrate against the
laying of edgstones & brick sidewalks on M. T. Vernon St
at the present time as petitioned for by E. A. Alger & others; —
as the sidewalks on said street are far better to day than
many where bricks have been laid; especially on Linnaean St.
and also in front of the estate of Mrs M. G. Howe North Avenue
where portions were relaid last year & portions are to be relaid
this year. The four petitioners, all told representing only
290 ft while your remonstrants represent 842 ft. Your remonstrants
were called upon last year to pay for a sewer in Lambert Avenue from
nine to ten hundred dollars, making from fifteen to sixteen hundred ^{dollars} for
sewerage; and one of your remonstrants wishes to have laid a brick
sidewalk on North Avenue from M. T. Vernon St to Lambert Avenue which will
require from twenty to twenty five ~~tht~~ brick; if suitable brick can be procured,
which is more important than side
streets at the present moment.
