- WHEREAS: The M.W.R.A., Cambridge's secondary source of water, has declared a possible water shortage in the near future; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to ask the Water Department to develop a specific water conservation program, that will give priority to water conservation under the City's control, such as repairing leaking water pipes, and will assist users to implement conservation measures; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council on what measures are undertaken.
