FRANKLIN COUNTY CELLULAR

Franklin County Cellular, Inc. ("Company"), a Massachusetts corporation, seeks permission from the Department to provide mobile paging and cellular telephone service within Massachusetts. The Company has also filed a proposed tariff of rates and charges for its services. The tariff is being investigated by the Department in docket D.P.U. 91-20.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Application of Franklin County Cellular, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws as amended, for a certificate as a Radio Utility, for the operation of a Mobile Radio Utility System for compensation within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Franklin County Cellular, Inc. ("Company"), a Massachusetts corporation, has filed a tariff of rates and charges for the provision of mobile paging and cellular telephone service within Massachusetts, which is the subject of this investigation by the Department. The Company is also seeking a certificate from the Department to provide the proposed service in docket D.P.U. 90-336.

Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in the following tariff: M.D.P.U. No. 1, filed with the Department on December 27, 1990 to become effective January 27, 1991 by Franklin County Cellular, Inc.
