WHEREAS: The open area between the Manning Building and the Central Square Library is regularly used by seniors residing in the Manning Building; and

WHEREAS: The activities of bicycle-riders and ball-players in that area has recently proved hazardous for senior residents; and

WHEREAS: One resident was struck by a ball thrown by children playing in the area; and

WHEREAS: Residents of the Manning Building have a right to feel safe in an area not designed for games or bicycle traffic; and

WHEREAS: Signs forbidding bicycle-riding and ball-playing in the open area directly adjacent to the Manning Building would seem to be the best solution; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council request the City Manager to arrange for the installation of such signs and report back to the City Council on this matter within two weeks.
