To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$191,802.00 into the Grant fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$62,964.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$128,838.00) from the Greater Boston Housing and Shelter Alliance (GBHAS). This contract continues the ongoing program for providing shelter for homeless persons at the YMCA and YWCA. The funds support two caseworkers who work directly with clients on placement and transitional needs. The funds also support contracts with the YMCA for 25 rooms and the YWCA for 5 rooms.
