- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby proclaim the week of November 17 to 23, 1985 as

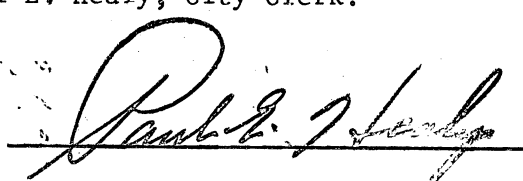
"AMERICAN EDUCATION WEEK"
