WHEREAS: It is a goal of this City Council to foster creative approaches to traffic, parking, and transportation needs of resident and businesses within the context of growing congestion, and the need to improve air quality; and

WHEREAS: Guiding this goal is a commitment to developing coexistence strategies for bicyclists, pedestrians, T users, and drivers; and

WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that the new residents of 70 Pacific Street, the new graduate students dormitories at Massachusetts Institute of Technology, have introduced a program where dorm residents may rent a bicycle for \$1 per day; and

WHEREAS: Twenty bicycles were acquired from Bikes Not Bombs, a Boston-based nonprofit organization which constructs bicycles on donated frames; and

WHEREAS: The goal of this program works in union with the above stated City Council goal to reduce dependency on motorized vehicles and reduce congestion; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on recording congratulating the residents of 70 Pacific Street on the introduction of this bike rental program and thanking them for their efforts to reduce pollution and congestion in the City of Cambridge; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record commending Anke Hildebrandt, coordinator of the program, and Massachusetts Institute of Technology for promoting the program; and be it further
