- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Albert H. Giroux, former long time Headmaster of the Somerville High School; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Giroux served virtually his entire career as an educator in the Somerville school system, beginning as a Teacher in Southern Junior High School 1929, holding various teaching and administrative positions throughout the system until being appointed as Headmaster in 1946 by the Somerville School Committee, holding that position until his retirement in 1974; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Giroux earned both an undergraduate and graduate degree from Boston College and undertook graduate studies at Harvard and Tufts Universities; and
- WHEREAS: During his tenure at Somerville High School, one of the largest in New England, Mr. Giroux's colleagues credited him with a number of innovations, including early childhood education, distributive marketing and occupational educational programs, programs for which he was honored by the Massachusetts Principals Association for his leadership and service; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the Giroux family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Giroux family on behalf of the entire City Council.
