In Board of Aldermen, Feb 29, 1860.

Ordered,

That this Board meet at the corner of Court and Main Streets on Thursday, the fifteenth day of March next at three o'clock P. M. for the purpose of laying out said Court Street, from Main Street to Charles Street, and of making any alterations in the lines of said Court Street which may then be deemed best; and that notice be given to the owners of land abutting on said Court Street, to attend the public hearing mentioned, by publishing this Order in the Cambridge Chronicle and by service of a copy of this Order upon such owners according to the Statute in such case made and provided, that they may then and there appear and be heard.
