IN CITY COUNCIL

February 26, 1979

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 53A, the City Council approves the acceptance of a gift of \$10,000.00 to establish a trust fund to be used by the library for the following purposes:

- To produce a series of publications in Cambridge History including attractive illustrated albums depicting Cambridge scenes and people, and monographs dealing with neglected personalities such as the political, business and cultural leaders who shaped the development of the City and the organizations, immigrant groups, issues and events whose story constitutes the history of Cambridge.
- To expand and preserve the holdings of the Cambridge Memorial Room through purchase of manuscripts, pamphlets and books related to Cambridge history; purchase of copying of illustrative materials such as photographs, drawings and prints showing Cambridge people, places and events; restoration of deteriorated materials; improvement of the storage environment and facilities; and the addition of suitable copying equipment.
- As in the case of most library trust funds, only the interest derived from the principal is to be expended.

In addition, the City Council accepts \$500.00 to augment the principal of the Carrie Saunders Fund, which is used to purchase books on art.

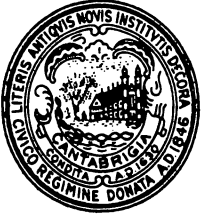


