I am taking this action in order to exercise several business options available to me at this time.

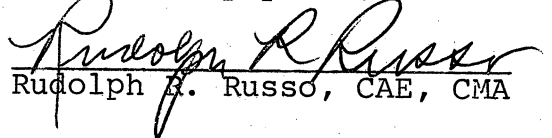
I have delayed this decision for approximately one year with the intention of administrating the conclusion of the revaluation program for fiscal 1982.
