- WHEREAS: President Reagan's recently proposed budget includes drastic reductions in or elimination of many urban programs, such as general revenue sharing, UDAG, CDBG, public housing, wastewater treatment, and mass transit funding; and
- WHEREAS: These cutbacks may have a very serious impact on the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Members of the City Council will soon be lobbying against many of these cutbacks at the National League of Cities Congressional Cities Conference in Washington, D.C. on March 23-26; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to have prepared a detailed analysis of how the President's proposed funding cutbacks will affect Cambridge, as was prepared in 1981; and be it further
- ORDERED: That this analysis be ready no later than March 18, 1985.
